Alpacas Kaydee 9th

Alpacas are South American camelid mammals, they are kind of like llamas, but they are actually smaller. They are an average of 3 feet high and 4-7 feet long. The average lifespan of an alpaca is about 20 years old, and they are usually safe and friendly to be around. Alpacas don't usually spit, but when they do, they are most likely really mad about something someone or another animal did, so that can cause them to spit. Alpacas have a soft fleece, which is highly sold for being very strong, but it is also very light weight. Alpacas have to have at least 2 other alpacas with them, otherwise they can end up getting sick and will eventually die living alone. There are no wild alpacas, they are domesticated, they live in high altitudes like the South American Andes. There are two types of alpacas- Huacaya and the Suri, and baby alpacas are called cria. Alpacas can come in about 22 different colors, from a deep blue-black to browns, tans, and whites. They also don't have teeth in the top front of their mouths, which is why they sometimes look a little weird.

In the past week alone reported covid-19 cases in Minnesota have reached the highest number we've had so far in 2021 at 21,547 known active cases with more than 2,500 new cases per day. The majority of the newly recorded cases in people recently are in people younger than 20, which in the past it's usually been people over the age of 20. The total number of covid-related deaths in Minnesota was 8,153 with an additional 17 new deaths reported last Friday bringing the total up to 8,170 deaths.

There are simple things we can do to help prevent the spread of covid-19 in our community. The MDH (Minnesota Department of Health) recommends wearing your mask in public spaces or large groups even if it isn't mandated, washing your hands often, and making sure to stay home if you're sick. These go for everyone whether you're vaccinated or not.
